1956

Precision Dynamics Corporation (PDC) is founded and develops the first singlepiece wristband for hospitals.

1972

Visa Band® product line for entertainment & recreation markets is introduced.

1976

Clincher®, an Inmate ID Wristband System, is launched becoming the first inmate ID solution for law enforcement and correctional facilities.

1079

PDC Produces Imprinter Style Wristband for healthcare.

1984

Setting the standards in automatic ID wristbands, the first Bar Code Wristband System for hospitals is developed.

1995

PDC is the first wristband ID company to earn ISO 9001 (International Standards Organization) certification at the main facility in San Fernando, CA.



1997

PDC purchases assets of Mark-Clark and Secur-Ticket divisions of M-C Industries expanding PDC's product offerings

2000

Smart Band® Radio Frequency ID (RFID) Wristband System is introduced.

2002

PDC Appoints Three New Members to its Board of Directors: Gary E. Hutchinson, Robert F. Foster, and Jonathon G. Lasch, Ph.D.

2002

Gary E. Hutchinson appointed as President & Chief Executive Officer.

2003

Advanced Marketing & Technology (AMAT) group is formed.

2004

PDC expands its patron management ID solutions with AgeBand® Electronic Age/ID Verification System, an electronic wristband solution to help prevent underage drinking.

2005

Cashless RFID Point-of-Sale System, Smart Kiosk®, Introduced
